Andrew Feldstein launches family law internet show

Divorce lawyer Andrew Feldstein of Feldstein Family Law Group has created a free, phone-in show, “Ask Andrew,” that will be broadcast live directly on the Internet on Thursday evening between 8-9 PM EST starting Nov. 5.

“We believe that ‘Ask Andrew’ is the only family law phone-in show, anywhere in the internet,” Feldstein said in a press release. “And let’s face it: who doesn’t want to talk to a lawyer, for free?”

The show will respond to questions about custody, child support, spousal support and division of family assets.

“It was the barrage of questions that got us thinking, ‘How can we answer more questions about separation and divorce?’” Feldstein said. “That’s when we came up with the idea of producing our own show and broadcast[ing] it directly to the web. The [Internet] is a miraculous thing and is able to connect those with problems to service providers.”

The news release cautions that the show will provide “useful legal information for viewers, but not legal advice.” Legal advice, Feldstein adds, can only be given “if there is a lawyer-client relationship established via a retainer agreement.”

But that’s not a bright line, and it could be tricky. Indeed, in describing questions that might be asked, Feldstein refers both to “questions that are common to many people” and “questions that are unique to your particular situation.” He does, however, provide guidelines that suggest questions should be general enough to benefit many listeners, not so personal as to allow identification and not confrontational.
